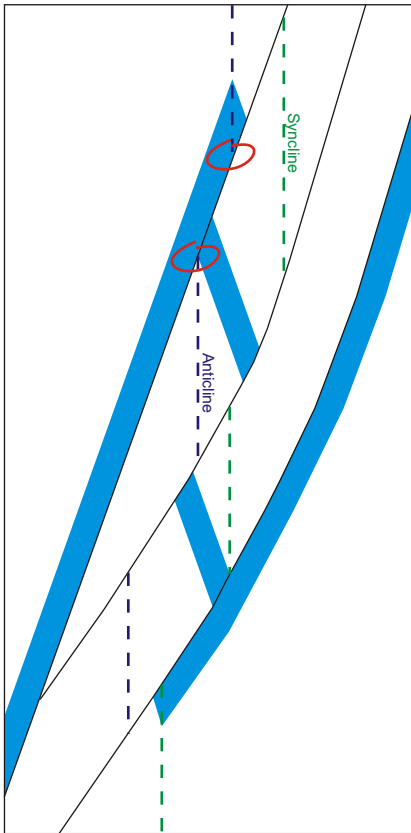
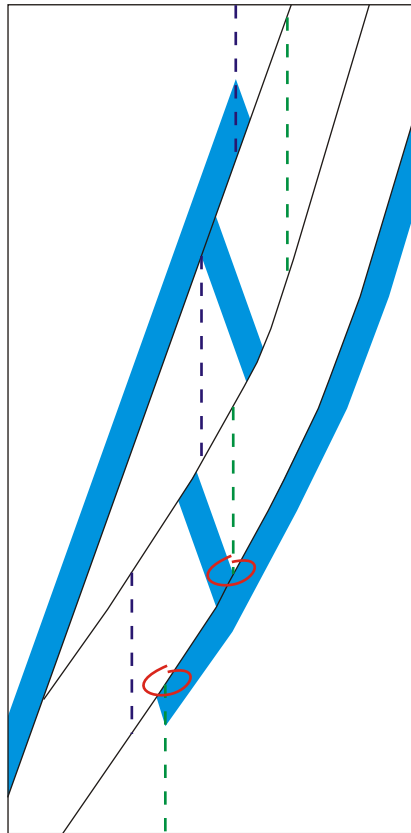


2.7. Interpretation rules and guidelines

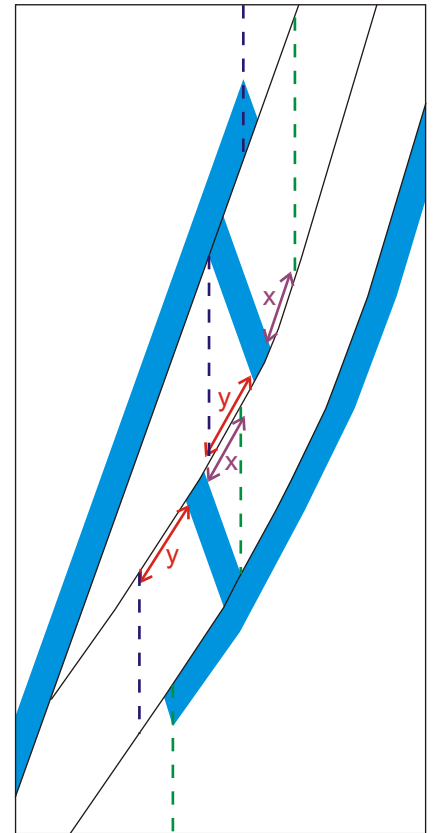
The base of the Black Shale should be in the core of the anticline on the Fosterville Fault. So if you know one, you can work out the other.



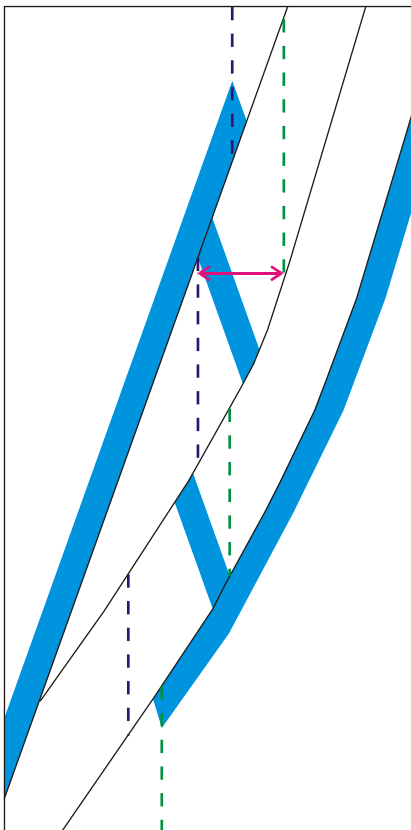
The top of the Phoenix Shale should be in the core of the syncline on the Phoenix Fault.



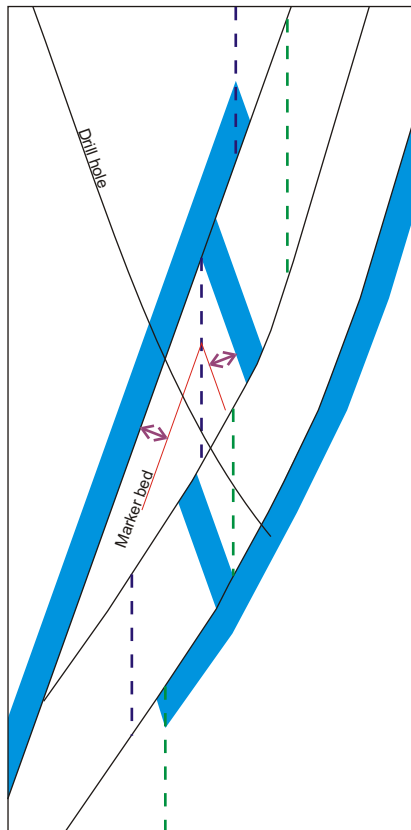
The distance between a marker bed and the hinge should be the same above and below a splay fault



The distance between folds can be determined



The geometry of marker beds can be constrained and the position of key beds inferred



With key pins on one drill hole, it should be possible to reconstruct the majority of a section
